 A. PAUL'S EARLY LIFE - 36-45 A.D.  
 1. EARLY TRAININGa. Ancestry and youth - Phil 3:4-6b. Education - Acts 22:3

2. SAUL THE PERSECUTORa. Stephen's death - Acts 7:57,58b. General persecutions - Acts 8:3

3. PAUL'S CONVERSION, 36 A.D.a. On the road to Damascus - Acts 9:1-9b. Paul and Ananias - Acts 9:10-16

8. JERUSALEM AND ANTIOCHA. Paul's second visit to Jerusalem, with alms - Acts 11:27-30b. Paul and Barbanas return to Antioch, 47-48 A.D - Acts 12:25
